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PLAYWRIGHT'S NOTES | NOTAS DEL DRAMATURGO

We come from fascism and towards fascism we go.

I started writing this story in 2007 thanks to Hugo Medrano and GALA. I was immediately mesmerized by the fantastic and powerful story of what happened to Evita's body. I confess that from the beginning the *Eva/Mummy* seemed more relevant, current, and necessary to me than the woman who in life had so much control, power, and won the affection of her people.

Maybe because as a mummy, Eva was a victim, and as such she was very close to my literary universe. After all, what happens to one human being, in some specific place, also happens to all people everywhere. And societies, we already know, at some point in their history feel an uncontrollable and incomprehensible desire to commit suicide.

This incredible story of Eva Perón's mummy began in 1952. However, it not only seems like news from just yesterday, but also events that will happen tomorrow. It is clear to me that today, as at that time, we are terrified witnesses to the advent of a new fascism. A nationalist, tyrannical, terrorist, and totalitarian version of power that is gradually being imprinted not only in our most intimate perceptions but also in the control of States. This is no fascism "light" I am talking about, but one that is celebrated and defended, a fascism born in our inner circle, in the living room of our homes, which then spreads to the masses.

And that's it: this work is not about Evita, not even about the pilgrimage of her corpse. It is about us, here and now, making crucial decisions: either we reveal ourselves without respite or we succumb without resistance to those fangs that come to us in the shape of our long-time scars.

Venimos del fascismo y hacia el fascismo vamos.

Comencé a escribir esta historia en 2007 gracias a Hugo Medrano y GALA. De inmediato, me dejé llevar por la fantástica y poderosa historia de lo sucedido al cadáver de Evita. Confieso que desde el principio la Eva/Momia me pareció más relevante, actual y necesaria, que la mujer que en vida tuvo tanto control del poder y se ganó el cariño de su pueblo.

Tal vez porque como momia, Eva era una víctima y, como tal, estaba muy cerca de mi universo literario. Después de todo, lo que le pasa a un ser humano, en algún lugar específico, le sucede también a todas las personas en todos los sitios. Y que las sociedades, ya lo sabemos, en algún momento de su historia sienten un deseo incontrolable e incomprensible de suicidarse.

Esta increíble historia de la momia de Eva Perón comenzó en 1952 y, sin embargo, no solo nos parece una noticia de ayer mismo, sino también sobre hechos que ocurrirán mañana. Para mí está claro que, como entonces, hoy somos testigos aterrados del advenimiento de un nuevo fascismo. Una versión del poder nacionalista, tiránica, terrorista y totalitaria que se está instalando poco a poco no solo en nuestras percepciones más íntimas, sino también en el control de los Estados. Hablo de un fascismo nada "light", muy celebrado y defendido, un fascismo que nace siendo doméstico, en la sala de nuestros hogares, para luego convertirse de masas.

Y eso es: esta obra no es sobre Evita, ni siquiera sobre el peregrinaje de su cadáver. Es sobre nosotros, aquí y ahora, tomando decisiones cruciales: o nos revelamos sin tregua o sucumbimos sin resistencia a esos colmillos que llegan con la forma de nuestras cicatrices.

DIRECTOR'S NOTES | NOTAS DEL DIRECTOR

Eva Perón has been a global icon for decades. The young Argentine actress, who in the 1940s captivated the heart of the most important man in her country to become the "Spiritual Head of the Nation," awakened the love of millions and parted the sea in Argentina so crudely that those who hated her wrote on the walls of Buenos Aires: "Long live cancer." Eva aroused passions because Eva did not remain silent, because Eva did not settle, because Eva was a woman.

I like to think of this play as a work of musical documentary theater. *Mummy in the Closet* does not tell the story of Eva Perón but the story of what happened to Eva's corpse and what the living did to a dead Eva. That, what Eva awoke after she died, is the incredible world that will be revealed to you tonight. What you will see on stage really happened. Music and humor, valuable balms for the harsh reality, are the channel through which we will try to reflect on hatred, violence, and intolerance, the evils that cyclically attack us.

Eva Perón es desde hace ya décadas un ícono a nivel mundial. Esa joven actriz argentina que en los años 40 cautivó el corazón del hombre más importante de su país, para convertirse en la "Jefa espiritual de la nación", despertó el amor de millones y dividió aguas en la Argentina de manera tan cruda que, quienes la odiaban llegaron a escribir en las paredes de Buenos Aires: "Viva el cáncer". Eva despertó pasiones porque Eva no se callaba, porque Eva no se conformaba, porque Eva era mujer.

Me gusta pensar en la obra como una obra de teatro documental musical. Momia en el clóset no viene a contar la historia de Eva Perón; nuestra obra relata lo que le sucedió a su cadáver, lo que le hicieron los vivos a una Eva muerta. Y eso que despertó Eva después de muerta es el mundo increíble que se revelará ante sus ojos esta noche. Lo que verán en el escenario sucedió realmente. La música y el humor, valiosos bálsamos para la dura realidad, son el canal a través del cual trataremos de reflexionar sobre los odios, la violencia y la intolerancia, que son males que cíclicamente nos atacan.

SYNOPSIS | SINOPSIS

When Eva dies in 1952, at age 33, her husband, President Perón, orders that her body be embalmed to make her immortal. He entrusted the conservation of the corpse to the prestigious anatomist Pedro Ara, so that he could turn Evita into "a statue," while they built a monument "that could be seen from the moon." But a coup d'état in 1955 overthrew the government and Perón fled into exile.

Immediately, the new government found itself with a serious predicament: what to do with Eva's body? The poor and the working class loved her, but the military and the bourgeoisie despised her. Thus, to prevent her body from being used as a political weapon, the president ordered the mummified corpse be kidnapped and vanished.

This is the fascinating, fantastic, incredible, but true story of what happened to Evita's corpse. Her mummification, attacks on her physical integrity, disappearance, and exile were a kind of dress rehearsal for what would later happen not only to the Argentine people, but also to Latin America, in what we then knew as the "Dirty War" and which we continue suffering today as "State-sponsored Terrorism."

Any resemblance to real people, living or dead, or to true events — and even to events occurring in 2024 — is no coincidence.

Cuando Eva muere en 1952, a los 33 años, su marido, el presidente Perón, ordena que su cuerpo sea embalsamado para hacerla inmortal. Encomendó la conservación del cadáver al prestigioso anatomista, Pedro Ara, para que convirtiera a Evita en "una estatua", mientras construían un monumento "que pudiera ser visto desde la luna". Pero un golpe de Estado en 1955 derrocó el gobierno y Perón huyó al exilio.

De inmediato, el nuevo gobierno se encontró con un grave problema: ¿qué hacer con el cuerpo de Eva? Los pobres y los obreros la querian, pero los militares y la burguesía la detestaban. Así, para evitar que fuera utilizado como arma política, el presidente ordenó secuestrar el cadáver momificado y hacerlo desaparecer.

Esta es la fascinante, fantástica, increíble, pero verídica historia de lo que le sucedió al cadáver de Evita. Su momificación, ataques a su integridad física, desaparición y exilio fueron una especie de ensayo general de lo que luego le sucedería no solo al pueblo argentino, sino también a Latinoamérica, en lo que conocimos entonces como la "Guerra Sucia" y que hoy sequimos sufriendo como "Terrorismo de Estado".

Aquí, cualquier parecido con personas reales, vivas o muertas, o con acontecimientos verídicos — y hasta con hechos que están ocurriendo en pleno 2024 — no es pura coincidencia.
